Scott Williams joined Target Insurance Services in 2002 as Vice President of Underwriting and General Manager of our Naperville, Illinois office. In November, 2009, he was promoted to Chief Underwriting Officer with profit and loss responsibility for all of Target's nationally recognized programs.

Prior to joining Target, Scott was employed by Interstate Insurance Group, serving as Vice President of Non-Medical Professional Liability programs.
